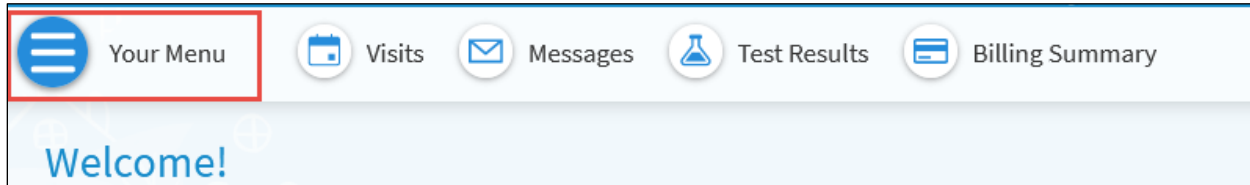


How to View Clinical Data

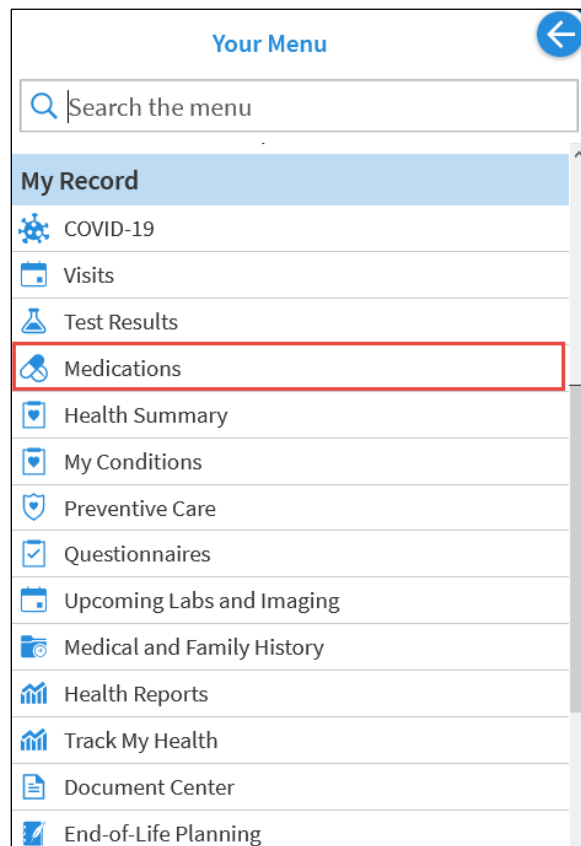


There is a variety of Clinical Data available in MyChart. The Clinical Data available to you is based on your record.

- 1) **Medications** – to view the current list of Medications in your record, first select “Your Menu”.



- 2) From the drop-down menu locate “My Record” section and select “Medications”.







- 6) **Preventive Care** – Based on your health history, age, and sex, this page displays screenings that you may be due for. To view your Preventive Care, from the Health Summary page, click Preventive Care.

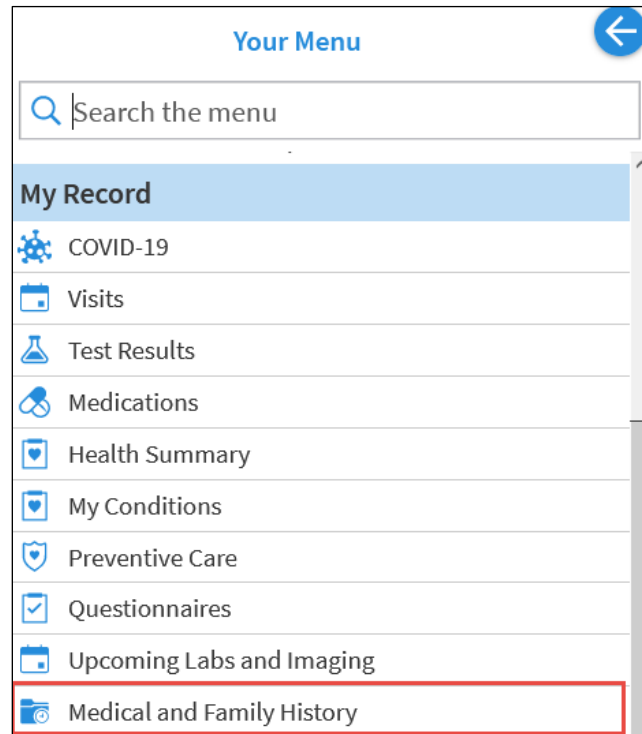

- 7) **Immunizations** – You can view a list of immunizations that your provider has on file for you. To view your Immunizations, from the Health Summary page, click Immunizations.

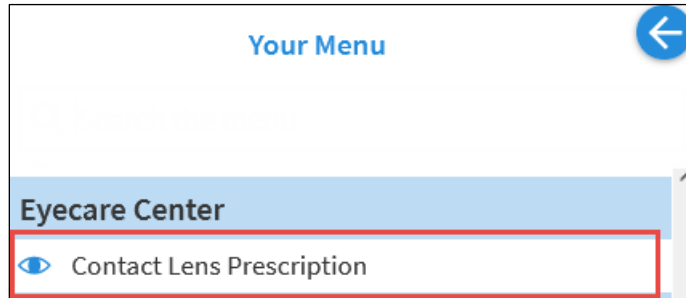

How to View Clinical Data



- 9) **EyeCare Center** – You can view and print your last contact lens/glass prescription in your medical record. To view your last prescription, first select “Your Menu”. From the drop-down menu locate the “Eyecare Center” section and select “Contact Lens Prescription”.



A printable summary of your last prescription will display. Click on the Printer icon on the top right corner of the screen to print the prescription.
